▲ NEW YORK, N.Y.: A life that changed from that of a dentist in 1930s New York to that of a Guggenheim Award-winning selftaught sculptor by the mid-1980s deserves special attention. Michael Rosenfeld Gallery's "Seymour Lipton: From Wood to Metal (A Fifty Year Survey)" explores Lipton's five-decade career as a sculptor who created works, including "Returning" in 1970, inspired by war, social unrest and the threat of technology.
